Advanced (aimed at those aged 17-20)	15 competencies (proof through reflections, photos and certificates of participation)	1 year (verified by an adult involved in the activity)	<u>Residential element</u> (of at least 2 nights e.g. D of E, NCS, school trip, language exchange, outward bound activity, ACF/CCF camp, sports camp, university taster experience) <u>Work experience</u> (of at least 10 days - includes starting up a business or P/T job) <u>Active Citizenship</u> (at least one unpaid community action activity e.g. volunteering, mentoring others, fundraising, coaching others, First Aid course, setting up a local action group)	15 Reflections at Advanced level
